Theme:

Warm-Up:

Yes, Circle/ bean game (Jamie)

Voice warmup (Leah)

Ewy Chewy Toffee into Vocal Warm-Up

Have the students pantomime finding a piece of toffee in their pocket, unwrap it, and put it in their mouth

Have them "chew" the sticky piece of candy

Have them explore the movements of the 'toffee' in their mouths

Up and down

Side to side

Chin out/in

Toffee stuck

A big piece of toffee that gets smaller

See how the voice changes afterwards from exercising the jaw and the face

Objective 1: Inventing story: Crazy Answers (Jamie)

1. Ask two players to take the stage and face the class (the audience).
 2. The two players have a close relationship (siblings or best friends).
 3. Explain that you will ask the players a question about something mischievous they did and together they must come up with an explanation. For example, "Josh, Amanda! How did my favorite jewelry end up at the bottom of the pool?"
 4. One player starts, then turns to the other who continues the story, then they continue back and forth.
 5. The audience may raise their hands and ask questions along the way.
 6. Encourage the two players to work together to craft a consistent (if outlandish!) story
- Objective 2: Prep for script work.

Finish creating characters and their environments? If students are finished drawing their characters, let's take them through a basic character analysis.

Age, Name, Personality Traits, Costume/Outfit, Is there a prop/accessory that your character has?

Reflection: Name something you did well today.
